

# **Boschendal Mountain Bike Trail**

Starting Point Franschoek Western Cape Province South Africa

Last Review: Thursday, 14th March 2019



There are 5 marked routes: **9km Green** and **11km Blue** routes for easy to moderate riding. The **15km Red** route for stronger riders. The **23km Black** route for more advanced riders. The variable **Black XL route** adds 3-4 sections onto Black route to add between 7 to 10km's of additional riding. The **4km Yellow** route is a skills track with options for both beginner and advanced riders.

Highlights include the 3.7km Inferno downhill single track through the forested slopes of the Simonsberg, the sweet Sugar Bowl with its fast technical sections and the pure-fun Porcupine singletrack corkscrewing through a forested section.

The marked trails consist of a large percentage of well-maintained single track, mountainside jeep track and some farm road.

Riders are welcome to make use of the **30 to 40 km's of unmarked tracks and farm road** to create their own circuits and longer rides.

### Route

There are 3 marked routes in this incredible MTB path: a 12km easy Blue Route (250m elevation) ; a 15km (400m Elevation) Red Route for stronger riders; and the 23 km (650m elevation) Black Route for more advanced riders.

Highlights include Sugar Bowl and Porcupine the very sweet downhill sections, Inferno the 3km downhill single track through the forested slopes of the Simonsberg and the testing Big Bunny ascent.

The marked trails consist of a large percentage of well-maintained single track, mountainside jeep track and some farm road. Riders are welcome to make use of the 30 to 40 km's of unmarked tracks and farm road to create their own circuits and longer rides.
